Additional instructions for vegetation debris removal for slash events related to fire mitigation on private properties along the roadsides and easements.

- No slash piles are to be placed within 4 feet of any green delineator.
- No slash piles are to be placed near utilities or trees and live vegetation.
- Slash Piles are to be placed alongside the shoulder of the road and not on the road.
- Slash Piles are NOT to be placed in drainage ditches or culverts.
- Slash Piles are NOT to be placed on walking paths or trails.
